Field trip of std. V & VI

Students of standard V and VI went on a field trip to BNHS where the students got a hands-on experience by going through a nature trail.

"The beauty of the natural world lies in the details."

The BNHS Nature Reserve is a verdant, lush patch of forest, thriving with natural life of all kinds. The field trip included a combination of theme-based outdoor activity (a nature trail) and indoor activity (a PowerPoint presentation by one of the BNHS guides.)

On the Nature Trail, the students were first led to the butterfly garden and the students were shown flowering plants that attracted various kinds of butterflies. He also showed them how to identify the butterflies. The students got an opportunity to observe a white spider that waited on a flower to devour the butterflies.

Then the students were taken on the leopard trail, treading through real forest where they could encounter various types of plants and animals. The guide encouraged the students to locate interesting things and asked questions about them. Various unique plants like the Indian ghost tree, Cup and saucer plant, basket shaped fungus, coral Mushrooms, the plant that produce bio diesel, wild turmeric etc were pointed out and their features were explained to the students. The children were also made to walk across the cold water streams. It was a wonderful learning experience for the students.
