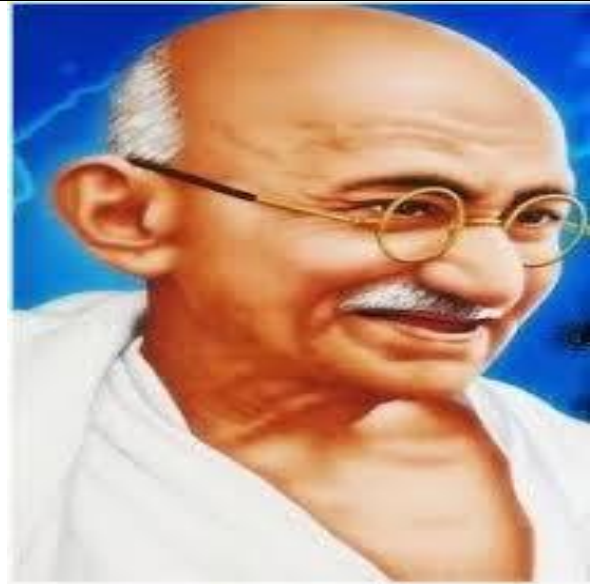


GANDHI JAYANTI

The theme of the project was **FOOD AND FESTIVAL OF INDIA**.

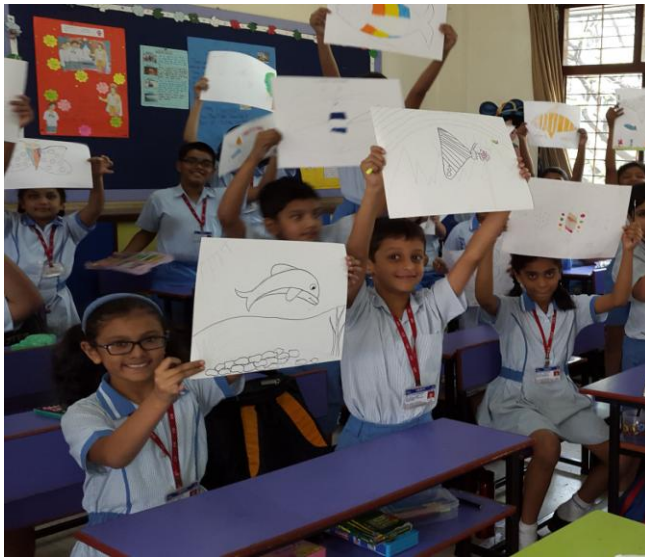

The students brought decorating materials, pictures and scrap book to the class. After the long break, the students began writing in the scrapbook and completed their project in the class. The time duration was one hour.



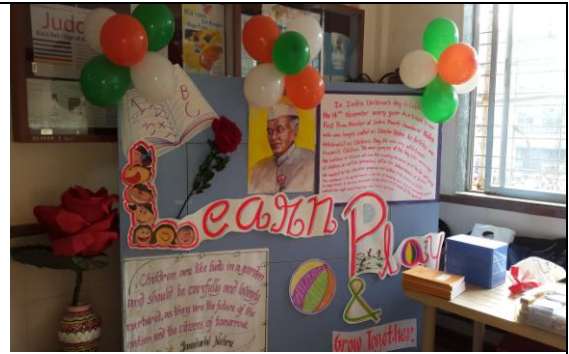
On the **24TH OF NOVEMBER,**
